Dr Anupam Krishna Dixit (b 1970) is Principal Scientist & Head Extension Education and Socio-Economics Section at the ICAR-Central Institute for Research on Goats (CIRG), Makhdoom, Farah, Mathura, India. He obtained his M.Sc. in Livestock Economics from ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Izatnagar and Ph.D. degree from Institute for Agricultural Sciences (IASc), Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi. His research interests include Livestock Development and Planning, Environment and Livestock, Value Chain Assessment, Agricultural Marketing, Agribusiness Management and Impact Assessment. Dr. A.K.Dixit has published more than 70 research articles in peer-reviewed national and international journals, 4 books and a discussion paper on International Development Strategies.
